Activities and projects

Our activities are grounded in the idea that voices education and direct support to the LGBT community as affirmative facets that are able to change for the better both health protection and societal position of LGBT individuals whose civil and human rights are being discriminated.

Throughout nine years of our committed work we have participated in various researches and have realized numerous projects within the area of education and prevention of HIV and STIs among LGBT community. Our main goal is to positively influence LGBT community to adopt protective skills and attitudes by gaining common knowledge and raising awareness related to HIV/AIDS and STIs.

The main methods of our work are based on the principles of voluntarism, confidentiality and accessibility.


About Drop-in Center

As one of our crucial results that we have achieved through our extensive involvement, the first Drop-in Center in Belgrade was opened in 2009 with the intention to provide adequate access to health protection and care and also to provide support to LGBT persons when it comes to the concerns raised by HIV/AIDS and STIs among this community.

Our goal is to offer people within the LGBT community a safe space where they may get adequate psychosocial support, possibility of voluntary and confidential testing for HIV and STIs, and also counseling with a health professional for skin and venereal diseases.

Our future activities

During the course of 2011 we will commence a project that is designed to deal with the issues of sustainability of Drop-in Center in Belgrade and that will also research further potentials of this kind of support that we are offering to the LGBT community. Also our future activities will be directed towards continual advancement of our current work and in the near future we will strive to expand our field of social actions and involvements.
